## FORMER FAO AND OTHER UN STAFF ASSOCIATIONS - FFOA ROME

## Who can become a member of FFOA?

- any retired staff member of a United Nations organization or agency that belongs to the United Nations system who has had a minimum of five years of service with such organization or agency and receives or is entitled to receive, upon retirement, a benefit from the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund (UNJSPF);
- the spouse of a member;
- the surviving spouse of a member, provided that the spouse receives a benefit from the UNJSPF;
- the surviving spouse of a staff member of one of the United Nations organizations or agencies referred to above who would have become entitled to membership;
- the recognized surviving dependant(s) of a member provided such dependant(s) receive(s) a benefit from the UNJSPF;
- a serving staff member of FAO, IFAD or WFP as associate member.
